### SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

#### **Executive Committee**

The Executive Committee did not meet.

#### Medical Standards (David Ben-Eli, MD, Chair)

The LVO Stroke Initiative was discussed. Regional hospitals were sent letters regarding ability to participate in the regional LVO Stroke initiative. At this time hospitals are responding, and data is being collected to identify potential participants. This information is being shared with FDNY. There are currently 8 hospitals that have CSC certification. FDNY confirmed that until a 30-minute transport time can be met, the new Stroke Protocol cannot be implemented. The following comes in the form of a seconded motion from the Medical Standards Committee: "Postpone implementation of Stroke Protocol and associated GOP and Appendices until April 1, 2019." A roll call vote was taken, and unanimously approved the motion.

The Certification & Credentialing Committee will work on the following:

- Develop standardized elements for CME flyers
- Ensure that ALS agency medical directors meet current credentialing requirements
- Develop requirements for the credentialing of medical directors providing CME
- T&E Committee will work with C&C to review and accept content of CME and assign credits.

#### REGIONAL COUNCIL UPDATE

#### TRAINING & EDUCATION COMMITTEE UPDATE (MORDY LAX, CHAIR)

The Training and Education Committee met on October 29, 2018. The following is a meeting summary:

# **Technology and REMSCO Website:**

Different ways to expand training presence on webpage was reviewed:

- Joseph Raneri gave information regarding the Adobe Connect program used to post training courses on the REMSCO NYC LMS (Learning Management System). We are also waiting for activation of the REMSCO mobile application, which has been over a year in development. Being approved by apple. Will be approved for download soon.
- T&E will review possibility of posting instructor level CME credit courses, and also identifying core and non-core CME.
- A new page will be created on the website showing chairs and how to contact them.
- Due to provider need, a list of available PSE sites will be posted.
- CentreLearn solutions was discussed. <a href="http://www.centrelearnsolutions.com/">http://www.centrelearnsolutions.com/</a>. CentreLearn is an online training management system.
- A method to distribute information more effectively to all agencies and EMS providers was discussed. Constant Contact, a program that allows for excellent information dissemination for groups, was discussed.

<u>Stop the bleed:</u> The need to promote Train-the-trainer courses and offer provider classes was discussed.

<u>Succession Planning:</u> The need for additional Regional Faculty and Program Coordinators was discussed. We will work with other regions to identify problems with education and get this info to Ryan Greenberg, NYS DOH BEMS.

<u>Newsletter</u>: In order to increase Brand recognition it was suggested the regional newsletter be resurrected.

#### Stroke:

- Great collaborative project.
- Video-based training (2 videos): didactic with physician presentations.

- Breaks down what Stroke is, and why we're shifting our stroke scale to look at severity. 2nd video is done at FDNY, crews doing assessment simulated patients. scenario cards.
- Videos will be on Adobe Presenter
- Providers will take test for each video, then take an over-all test to get certificate.
- Hands on done by individual agency training site, using skill cards.
- Standardized training.
- Stroke materials will be sent to all to TE members, so a training package can be created. <u>January protocol update</u>: A training package will be created to accompany new protocols, and placed on LMS.

<u>Instructor Courses:</u> The CIU outline was rejected by NYS DOH. They requested additional explanation for BLS 12 Lead ECG module and pediatrics module. Outlines will be emailed to TE members for review. (*Follow-up: course outline was reviewed and approved by Jean Taylor, NYS DOH. The course will be held on November 18, 2018.)* 

## JOINT REMSCO/REMAC QA COMMITTEE UPDATE (MICHAEL REDLENER, MD, CHAIR)

The Joint Regional Emergency Medical Services Council/Regional Emergency Medical Advisory Committee (REMAC) Quality Improvement Committee met on Thursday, November 8, 2018. The following is a meeting summary:

- NYS DOH BEMS is involved. We will proceed based on NYS DOH BEMS direction.

#### Stroke

- Stroke letter was sent out by GNYHA to hospitals inviting them to participate. Responses are being received.
- NYS DOH still has not chosen designating entities for Thrombectomy Stroke Centers. A
  clarification may need to be sent out. It was suggested that an FAQ be created with NYS
  DOH input.

#### Safety TAG:

- Awaiting NYS DOH document, which is being created. Still working on a regional draft. First Watch
  - The QA Grant associated with this project was discussed. QA tool. In conjunction with AHA re: STEMI & Stroke.
