



Dear Ezras Nashim,

I recently gave birth to my seventh child, a healthy baby girl...in an ambulance.

BH she and I are both healthy and I am so thankful to Hashem.

I of course I appreciate the EMTs who responded to the call, as they were doing their job and they behaved professionally and did good on their training.

I live in Israel and there is no Ezras Nashim available where I live, however I can tell you that as I lay there terrified in the back of an ambulance, I must have thought a thousand times: I wish I had Ezras Nashim to call.

My first six births were all under epidural, and I had intended to give birth to my seventh child with an epidural of course in the hospital. I labored at home and was completely in control, which led me to believe that I was still in the early stages of labor. When I started walking out the door with my husband to leave to the hospital, I felt a tremendous pressure, and was afraid to get into the car, and told him to call the ambulance.

Of course I was not as composed as this email might make it seem. I was shaking like a leaf and when the ambulance pulled up, I held on to the wall surrounding my neighbours home, I refused to get into the ambulance and had to be physically forced onto the stretcher.

I needed a trained woman to look me into the eye and tell me, you're ok, you can do this, we are here for you...

It was nothing like that.

After the birth, I realized that I had experienced what psychologists describe as dissociation, I literally separated my head from my body. I did not want to believe what was happening to me.

My baby was born healthy, and that is the main thing, but I wish somebody would have been there to comfort me as I was having intense contractions, I wish somebody had held out a hand to squeeze, I wish I could have had a more positive birth experience.

Thank you for establishing your organization and for all the work you do. You may not have been able to help me, but it feels so good to know that there are women who have the good fortune of being able to count on other women when they need it most!

I have given birth six times in a hospital setting, and had men deliver me, it is absolutely not the same thing as delivering in the back of an ambulance or if I had given birth unexpectedly at home.

The back of an ambulance is scary, it's nothing like what you thought your birth would be like. I cannot describe the experience of lying on an ambulance stretcher with my baby in my hands. By the time, my baby was born I was in such a dissociative state, I did not fully connect to the idea that I was holding my own baby.

I tried to remain calm as my placenta was not coming out and I was experiencing massive bleeding, once I got to the hospital, they took the baby and I delivered the placenta.

To Whom it May concern,

I am writing to express my gratefulness
to Ezrat Nashim

Nearly Seven months ago, I experienced a difficult time in my life. My days were full of anxious and depressive thoughts that despite my best efforts I could not overcome. I tried desperately to regain control of my emotional and mental health. I consistently went to my weekly therapy appointments, monthly psychiatrist visits, as well as bi-weekly counseling with my husband - yet somehow I still struggled to process my childhood trauma and pain.

One day, my typical stressors felt like too much to handle. My husband and I had a heated argument, and I ended up eating my Shabbos meal alone. This triggered my old feelings of pain and loneliness and just became too much for me to bear. Looking for a way out of this darkness, I self-medicated on my anxiety prescriptions. Soon after, I realized that I did not feel well and I blocked out my semi-conscious state scared me, and I quickly realized my mistake. I called out for my husband, and I asked him to call Ezrat Nashim for help over Hatzolah, in order for me to be comfortable and modest.

Judge Frier accompanied me to the hospital and ensured that I received the necessary medical care. She was sensitive to my needs for modesty as an Orthodox Jewish woman and helped me privately change into my hospital gown. During the following weeks of recovery, Judge Frier remained on hand and quietly ~~refer~~ referred me to individuals and various organizations who could help me move past my pain. She supported me in coming to understand that this was one, negative choice that I could survive and even find a way to attach meaning to.

Over the following months, I decided that I would like to help give back to others through the same medium that I benefitted from. Thereafter, I enrolled in an EMT course to become certified to ~~be~~ volunteer with Ezra's Nashim.

It is my hope that Ezra's Nashim will have the ability to support more individuals on their respective paths in becoming EMTs properly equipped with ambulances and supplies. I do not doubt that anyone who helps Ezra's Nashim achieve this goal will feel positive effects of their actions for many years to come.

It is now 2 years since my first encounter with EzrasNashim. On Erev Rosh Hashana 2017, I was transferring a 16qt pot of chicken soup from the stove to the counter and I dropped the pot. The soup spilled on the floor and I fell right onto the boiling hot soup. I knew I needed help. I quickly called EzrasNashim who came immediately. They treated my wound and returned every hour to check on the wound and bandage it. I had lots of painful boils on my bottom and feet. For 4 weeks EzrasNashim came each morning and evening to apply cream and bandage the wounds until I was able to do it myself. It took 4 months to get better but I was left with no scars.





As we are halfway done with the summer, we wanted to take this time to reach out to our supporters to share exciting news and updates.




