The Regional Emergency Medical Advisory Committee (REMAC) of New York City is responsible to develop, approve and implement prehospital treatment and transport protocols for use within the five boroughs of the City of New York. The Regional Emergency Medical Advisory Committee (REMAC) of New York City operates under the auspices of Article Thirty of the New York State Public Health Law.

The NYC REMAC is working with the NYS DOH BEMS to provide online training on recently updated Unified Protocols. There are both BLS and ALS versions.

- Providers need take only one course, consistent with their level of certification.
- The ALS version includes all BLS update information.
- > BLS course should be posted by Monday, October 25, 2020
- > ALS course should be posted by November 1, 2020

This training is MANDATORY for all EMS providers in the NYC region. The course will update providers on the Unified Protocol changes that take effect January 1, 2021 and MUST be completed prior to that date.

Once the course is completed, a certificate will be generated. EMS Providers must provide a copy of the certificate to their EMS agencies as evidence of completion of the update.

• Agencies must place a copy of this certificate in the provider's personnel file.

Protocol update courses will be posted on the NYS DOH BEMS website at https://vitalsignsacademy.com/.

- Users must Log In and/or Register (right upper corner of screen) to be brought to the State's Learning Management System (LMS).
- Both courses will be posted once they are live.
- Specific links will be posted on the REMSCO website as soon as the courses are officially live.
- REMAC will be hosting virtual Q&A sessions regarding the updates. Links to the training will be posted on the REMSCO website.
