EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Josef Schenker reported that the Executive Committee did not meet. However, there was an email discussion about the statewide iGel Basic Life Support (BLS) Pilot Project being conducted by the Hudson Valley region, which aims to assess the feasibility of Emergency Medical Technicians' use of iGel supraglottic airway devices to treat patients who experience cardiac arrest. In our region, Jamaica and Flushing hospitals were approved to participate in the study by the Regional Council and the NYS Department of Health. However, REMAC did not review the project. Due to regional objections and concerns, Jamaica and Flushing Hospital postponed their operation until they could receive additional guidance from REMAC. The members of the email discussion proposed the creation of an advisory to inform the region and outline the necessary steps for Paramedics to manage iGel in the field that BLS providers started.

During the meeting, Nathan Reisman, MD, motioned "to support this project with the stipulation that an agency present it to the REMAC, and an advisory be issued." Joseph Bove, MD, seconded this motion.

Michelle Klemm conducted a roll call vote, and the results were 12 approved, 5 opposed, and 1 abstention. Although the motion was carried, it was reported that it did not pass.

The QA Committee will review the iGel Pilot Project and the QA requirements to develop an advisory that the Executive Committee will send out before the January REMAC meeting.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

Certification & Credentialing Committee (Paul Barbara, MD, Chair)

Paul Barbara, MD, reported that the Certification & Credentialing Committee met on November 16, 2023. The following is a summary:

- The committee is standardizing NYC REMAC Paramedic extensions. Providers will have to submit formal documentation and receive executive approval. Extensions for military leave, medical issues, and family needs will be granted. The committee will develop formal language and present it to REMAC.
- The Certification & Credentialing Committee is collaborating with the Training & Education Committee to create content for the annual updates based on earlier exams and topics.
- An OLMC Pathway is being created on the LMS to credential OLMC Physicians. The pathway streamlines the procedures rather than the education and content.
- New York State created a Credentialing Committee to examine regional credentialing. Paul Barbara, MD, Chair, encouraged attendance by REMAC members. The next virtual meeting will be held on November 27, 2023, at 2 P.M. For more information, contact Paul Barbara, MD.

Medical Standards (David Ben-Eli, MD, Chair)

David Ben-Eli, MD, reported that Medical Standards met on November 14, 2023. He said that a protocol is being forwarded to REMAC for voting. Pamela Lai, MD, presented the protocol for review in the Protocol Committee report.

The next Medical Standards Committee meeting is on January 9, 2024, at 3:00 P.M. via Zoom.

Protocol Committee (Pamela Lai, MD, Chair)

Pamela Lai, MD, reported that the Protocol Committee met on November 3, 2023. The following is a summary:

• Medical Standards brought forward a seconded motion to REMAC to accept revisions to the "Head, Neck and Spine Injuries (Adult and Pediatric)" protocol. One of the proposed changes is to replace the term "spinal precautions" with "spinal motion restrictions." Additionally, the proposal includes moving spinal restriction from the EMT section to the CFR section, defining the circumstances under which a nasopharyngeal airway should not be used for traumatic injuries, and specifying the situations where a cervical collar should not be used for penetrating trauma.

The language changes from "Spinal precautions" to "spinal motion restriction" must also be changed in the General Operating Procedures, other protocols, and the Appendix.

Michelle Klemm conducted a roll call vote, and the results were 19 approved, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions. The motion carried.

The next Protocol Committee meeting is on December 15, 2023, at 10:00 A.M. via Zoom.

QI Report (Michael Redlener, MD, Chair)

Joseph Raneri reported that the Q.I. Committee met on November 1, 2023. The following is a summary:

- The Quality Improvement Committee has received the latest updates on the ongoing projects.
- The implementation of the FirstWatch Dashboard is currently underway. Agencies that have updated their contact information should have already received access to the dashboard and a unique key code to identify their agency. While most agencies have responded, the committee is still awaiting updated data from some agencies.
- The committee has received the necessary documentation for a regional restriction case and is scheduling a meeting to review and decide on further action.
- A sponsor requested approval to upgrade their training level in the region. The committee is reviewing the application and seeking clarification from the NYS DOH regarding the requirements.

• The Quality Improvement (Q.I.) The Committee is creating Quality Assurance (Q.A.) project reports regarding advanced airway techniques and pain management.
